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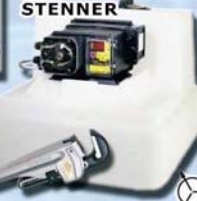
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## NEWS FROM THE STATE ENGINEER'S OFFICE BY JIM GODDARD — UTAH DIVISION OF WATER RIGHTS

### NEW POLICIES FOR RENOVATE APPLICATIONS AND PROVISIONAL WELL APPLICATIONS

**Renovate Application:** Previously, an approved *Application to Renovate An Existing Well* was required anytime a regulated activity was performed on an existing well. Regulated activities related to a Renovate permit included deepening, repair, renovation, cleaning, development, testing, and disinfection. In order to obtain a Renovate permit, a Renovate application needed to be filed with the Division of Water Rights. Upon approval of the application, an approval letter and start cards would be issued to the applicant, and the licensed driller would need to submit the start cards before the work and a well log following the work. With the recent promulgation of pump installation rules and processes, the policy regarding when and for what a Renovate permit is needed has been modified. Now, a Renovate permit is needed only when the well itself will be modified which includes activities such as deepening, casing/seal/gravel pack repair/renovation, liner installation, pitless adapter/unit installation, and perforating/screen installation. Other regulated well activities that do not modify the well itself such as cleaning, development, testing, disinfection, and pump work are covered under the Pump Installation rule and processes, and a Renovate permit is no longer required. However, this work must still be performed by a licensed well driller or pump installer and a pump log must be submitted upon completion of the regulated work. This new policy should reduce the amount of paperwork and administration for the applicant, licensee, and Division.

**Provision Well Applications (Rush Letter):** In certain situations, a water right applicant may desire to start drilling their production well before their water right application has been approved (which at times can take weeks to months to process). The Rush Letter approval issued by the Division's regional engineers allowed this to happen when justified. Previously, this process included filling out a non-production well (NPW) application in conjunction with the water application. There was a specific area on the NPW application for provisional well application. The provisional well application process has been slightly modified. The NPW application can no longer be used to apply for provisional well drilling approval. If a water right applicant desires and is justified in requesting provision approval to drill, the applicant must first file the appropriate water right application and provide a written letter request for provisional approval. The written request must provide statutory justification for needing provisional approval to drill the well. These requests will be reviewed by the regional engineer and evaluated based on merit and justification. It is possible that provisional approval could be denied or even delayed in the process (such as after the water right application protest period).

Pursuant to Section 73-3-5(4) Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, application can be made to the State Engineer to drill a provisional well. The subsection reference above is as follows:

*The state engineer may issue a temporary receipt to drill a well at any time after the filing of an application to appropriate water therefrom, as provided by this section if all fees be advanced and if in his judgment there is unappropriated water available in the proposed source and there is no likelihood of impairment of existing rights; provided, however, that the issuance of such temporary permits shall not dispense with the publishing of notice and the final approval or rejection of such application by the state engineer, as provided by this chapter.*

Prior to requesting provisional approval to drill a well, a water right application (i.e., new appropriation, change, exchange, temporary) must be filed for this same proposed well location. A provisional well request will be considered incomplete and will not be acted upon by the Division of Water Rights until the water right application has been filed.

It is understood that the reason for drilling a provisional well prior to water right application approval is to determine the quality and availability of an adequate water supply to support the beneficial uses requested in the water right application. Moreover, it is understood that the owner/applicant can prove a hardship or emergency situation that would warrant the approval of a provisional request to drill a production well prior to the water right application approval. The applicant is required to provide sufficient information in the written request to allow the State Engineer to evaluate the justification for granting provisional well drilling approval.

Provisional approval grants the permission to proceed with the construction of the well. It does not grant any permission or approval to divert or use the water for any purpose whatsoever, other than the minimal amount required for quality/quantity testing, until the underlying application has been formally approved by the State Engineer. If in the event that the water right application is rejected or otherwise denied, then the provisional well must be properly abandoned in accordance with R655-4-14 (UAC) and by a Utah licensed driller at the owner/applicants cost and risk.

If a provisional well application is approved by the State Engineer, the well shall be drilled and completed in accordance with the Administrative Rules for Water Wells (R655-4 UAC) by a Utah licensed well driller.
