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NEWS FROM THE STATE ENGINEER'S OFFICE BY JIM GODDARD — UTAH DIVISION OF WATER RIGHTS

NEW NATIONAL WATER WELL CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS NOW AVAILABLE

About eight years ago, the National Ground Water Association (NGWA) began the lengthy and meticulous process of developing a nationally accredited water well construction standard through the American National Standards Institute (ANSI). Many national experts from the industry contributed to this standard including drillers, suppliers, regulators, engineers, and scientists, including a few from Utah. The standard is now complete and fully accredited, and is titled ANSI/NGWA-01-14 Water Well Construction Standard (May 2014). This is a standard and not regulation; however, water well regulatory agencies may use this standard in the development/refinement of well drilling regulations. This standard attempts to set a baseline of expectations for water well system professionals to meet for residential, agricultural, monitoring, industrial, and public supply water wells. The standard seeks to contribute to public health and safety and resource protection.

Topics covered by the NGWA's first-ever third party-sanctioned standard include:

- Casing and casing installation
- Data recording
- Disinfection with chlorine
- Grouting
- Permanent well and test-hole decommissioning
- Plumbness and alignment
- Testing for performance
- Water sampling and analysis
- Well development
- Well site selection
- Well screens, filter pack, and formation stabilizer.

The ANSI/NGWA-01-14 Water Well Construction Standard is available through NGWA's online bookstore (NGWA.org).

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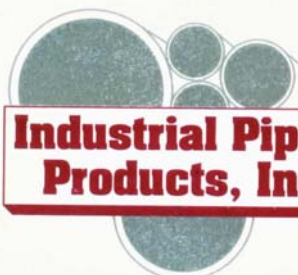


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- C. MANUFACTURER:** Any person engaged in the manufacturing of equipment, or materials used in the ground water industry.
