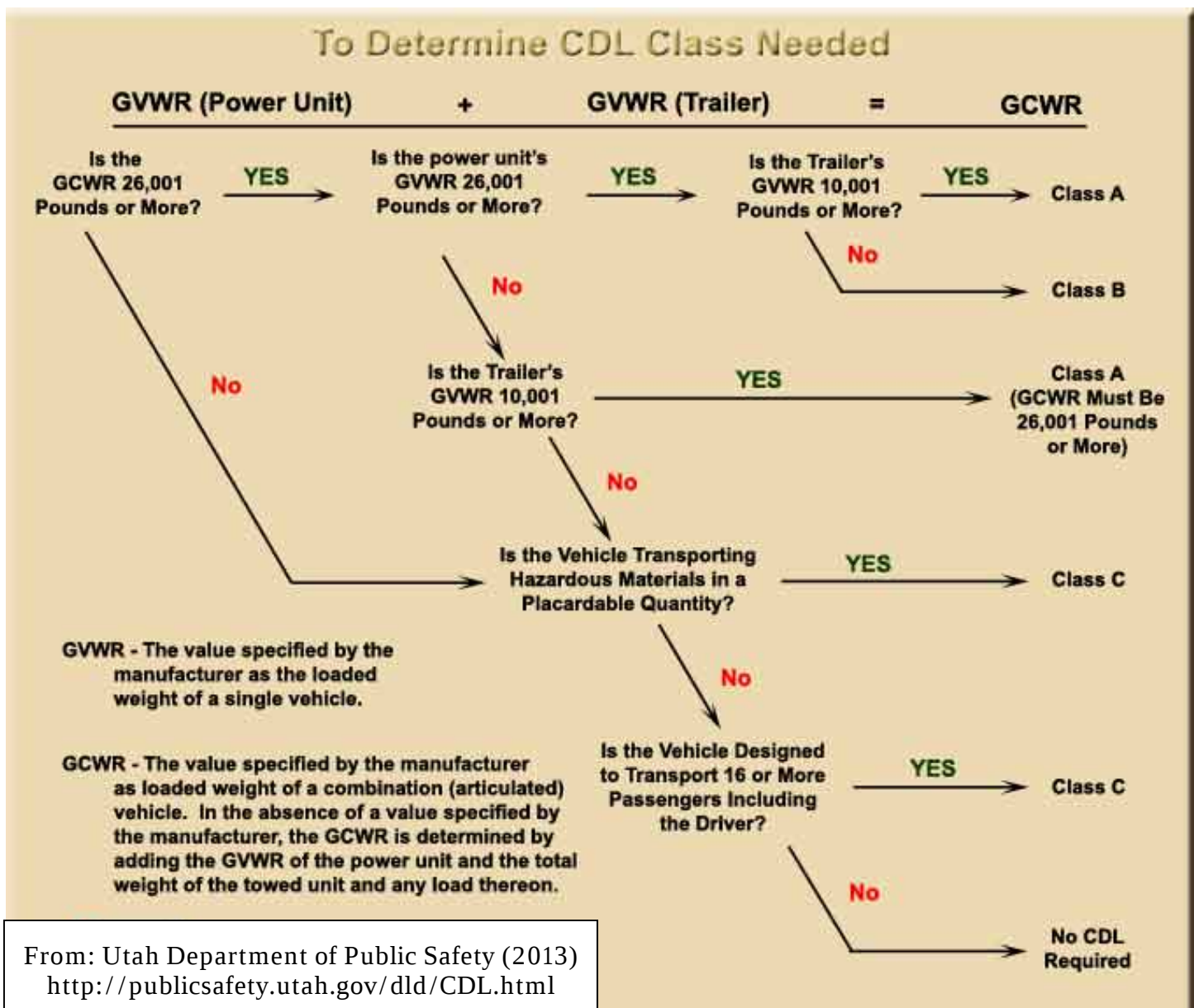
OFFICER BRUCE FOX — UTAH HIGHWAY PATROL

Commercial Driver's License

A driver must obtain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) to operate any of the following vehicles used to transport passengers or cargo:

- A single vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,001 pounds or more.
- A combination of vehicles with a combined gross vehicle weight rating of 26,001 pounds or more, when pulling a trailer rated for 10,001 pounds or more.
- A vehicle designed to transport 16 or more people (including the driver).
- Any size vehicle that requires hazardous materials placards.

A driver will be disqualified from operating a Commercial Motor Vehicle for a least one year if the driver is convicted of any of the following offenses:

- Being under the influence of alcohol or drugs while operating a CMV
- Driving a CMV with a blood alcohol level of 0.04 percent or more
- Leaving the scene of an accident involving a CMV
- Using a CMV to commit a felony
- Failing to stop at a railroad grade crossing when required to do so (disqualified for at least 60 days)
- Violating an out of service order (disqualified for at least 90 days)
- Causing a fatality through negligent operation of a CMV
- Operating a CMV when the driver's CDL is revoked, suspended or cancelled
- For not less than 60 days for offenses committed in a non-CMV as listed in [49 CFR 383.51](#)

CLASSES OF THE COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSES

Class C is valid for:

- Drivers operating Class D vehicles that transport hazardous materials in amounts that require the vehicle to be placarded. (A Class D license is valid for vehicles with a gross vehicle weight of 26,000pounds or less, or a vehicle combination with a power unit with a GVW of 26,000 pounds or less and a trailer with a GVW of 10,000pounds or less.)
- Drivers operating school buses designed to transport 15 or fewer passengers, including the driver. The license must show a School Bus endorsement.

Class B is valid for:

- A single unit vehicle with a GVW over 26,000 pounds.
- Vehicles designed to transport 16 or more passengers, including the driver. The holder of a Class B license may only tow vehicles with a gross vehicle weight of 10,000 pounds or fewer when operating a Class B power unit.
- Vehicle combinations in excess of 26,000 pounds that have towed units with a GVW over 10,000 pounds.

CDL ENDORSEMENTS [49 CFR 383](#)

Commercial drivers license endorsements are:

- H -Hazardous Materials
- K -Intrastate only -restriction
- L -Air brake -restriction
- N -Tanker
- P -Passengers
- S -School bus
- T -Double or triple trailer
- X -Tanker and hazardous materials

BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR DRIVERS WITH CDL HAZARDOUS MATERIALS ENDORSEMENTS

49 CFR 1572

The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) and the USDOT have issued regulations establishing new eligibility criteria for persons holding a hazardous materials endorsement on a CDL. No person may hold or renew a CDL with a hazmat endorsement, or be granted a new CDL with a hazardous materials endorsement if:

- The individual is not a United States citizen or lawful permanent resident of the United States.
- The individual has been convicted of a disqualifying criminal offense in the past seven years or released from incarceration in the last five years for committing any of the disqualifying offenses.
- The individual has been notified by the TSA that they pose a security threat as described in [40 CFR 1572.107](#)

Drivers renewing an existing CDL with a hazmat endorsement, and those persons applying for a new hazmat endorsement are required to submit fingerprints to facilitate the background criminal record check. Persons disqualified under provisions of these new security regulations will lose their hazardous materials endorsements, not their CDL. These persons must surrender their driver's license to the issuing state and will be issued a new driver's license without the hazardous materials endorsement.

EXEMPTION FOR FARMERS

49 CFR 383

Generally, a CDL is not required for operators of a farm vehicle that is controlled and operated by a farmer, including operation by employees or family members if the vehicle is:

- Used to transport either agricultural products, farm machinery, farm supplies or both to or from a farm.
- Not used in the operations of a common or contract motor carrier; and
- Is used within 150 miles of the farmer's farm.

This exception is limited to the driver's home state unless there is a reciprocity agreement with the adjoining states. There are some restrictions and exceptions when transporting hazardous materials and bulk liquids. For further information contact the Motor Carrier Division at (801) 965-4892 or (866) 215-5399.

COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S MANUAL

The Utah Commercial Driver's Manual, which is produced by the Utah Driver License Division, details the information required to obtain a CDL. 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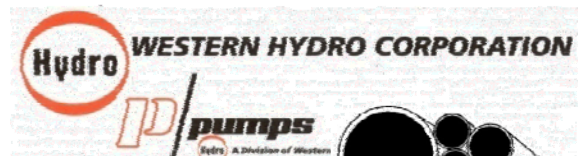
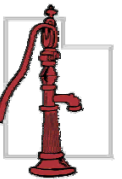

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Membership Types

- A. **CONTRACTOR:** Any person doing business and licensed to drill, either water wells or ground water monitoring.
- B. **PUMP INSTALLER:** Any person doing business and licensed to install ground-water pumping equipment.
- C. **MANUFACTURER:** Any person engaged in the manufacturing of equipment, or materials used in the ground water industry.
- D. **SUPPLIER:** Any person engaged in the sale of equipment or supplies associated with the ground water industry.
- E. **TECHNICAL:** Any hydrologist, geologist, or engineer involved in teaching, research, consulting and or government services associated with the ground water industry.
- F. **ASSOCIATE:** Any person engaged in the support of the UGWA who does not accurately fit in any of the above.

This membership allows the joining of one individual to benefit from all the privileges of membership in the Utah Ground Water Association. Annual membership dues are \$60.00 per year. These dues cover membership only in the Utah Ground Water Association. The Utah Ground Water Association is affiliated with the National Ground Water Association and the Mountain States Ground Water Association. **All memberships are annual and run July 1st thru June 30th. Memberships purchased mid-year will have the 2nd year pro-rated to bring them compliant with this format.**

IMPORTANT CHANGES TO YOUR UGWA MEMBERSHIP

All Annual UGWA Memberships will now run July 1st thru June 30th.

We are streamlining our membership process:

This will help eliminate confusion when you register for your events.

This change will cleanly separate your membership dues from your registration.

You will know your membership is up for renewal on July 1st each year.

We changed your membership number to a new easier to remember 4 digit #!

We understand that this may be confusing thru the transition period. Please be patient with us. Once your membership is running July to June, it will be much easier to know where you are at with your membership status.

Frequently Asked Questions

What can I do to help make this transition easier for me and the UGWA? Email us at admin@utahgroundwater.org and let us know! We will email you an invoice for the amount needed to get membership compliant with this change. For example: if your membership currently expires 01/12/14, \$20.85 would take you to June 30, 2014 (bal of Jan waived 5 months x \$4.17).

Will my membership fee change? The annual membership fee has increased from \$50 to \$60 per year. This amount makes it easier to prorate those who join mid-year at \$5 per month.

Is there a discount available to existing members? Yes! Simply renew your membership before July 31st and save \$10. That eliminates any increase at all!

How do I get my new membership #? You will receive an email before February 28, 2013 with your new number and your current expiration date.

What if I don't get my email or don't want to wait? Simply contact us at admin@utahgroundwater.org or 801.541.7259, we would be happy to help you.

Will I need my membership # to register for events? Yes, if you wish to receive your member discount/pricing. Think of it as your personal discount code.

What if my member # does not give me my registration discount?

Check to see if your membership expires before or during the event you are registering for. Your membership must be current thru the duration of the event to receive the member discount.

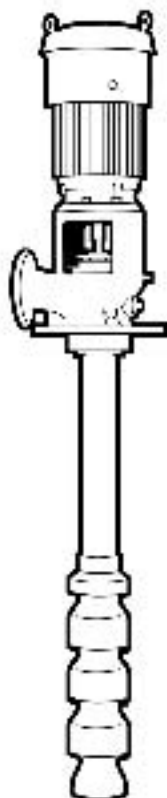
